Background and Practice Overview

Megan has substantial experience in litigation and advisory work in all aspects of intellectual property law. She has been involved in many landmark pharmaceutical patent cases; acted for numerous luxury brands in trade mark and Australian Consumer Law cases, including Louis Vuitton, Hugo Boss and Giorgio Armani; and acted in multiple copyright licensing and infringement cases for musical collecting societies Australasian Performance Rights Association and Phonographic Performance Company of Australia. Examples of significant cases that she has been involved in include the High Court appeal of AstraZeneca AB v Apotex Pty Ltd, regarding pharmaceutical patents for cholesterol drug rosuvastatin (Crestor); the first patent repair case in Australia, Seiko Epson Corporation v Calidad Pty Ltd; and the trade mark dispute In-N-Out Burgers, Inc v Hashtag Burgers Pty Ltd.

Prior to being called to the Bar, Megan was Associate to the Hon Justice Burley of the Federal Court of Australia. During that time, she had exposure to a wide variety of legal cases, in both first instance and appellate jurisdictions. Megan has also previously been a Senior Associate in MinterEllison's intellectual property disputes team; in-house IP Counsel for generic pharmaceutical company Hospira, (now Pfizer); and solicitor at King & Wood Mallesons.
